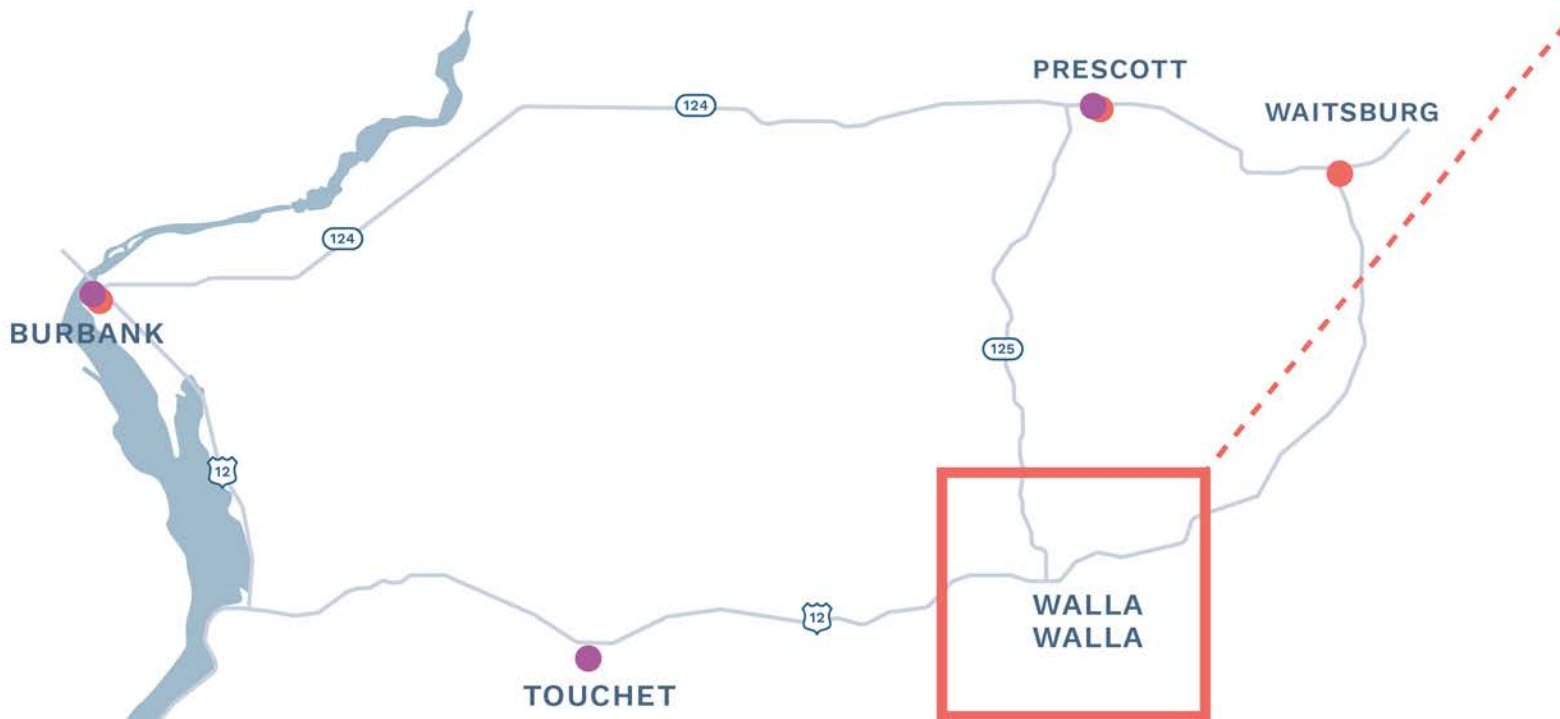

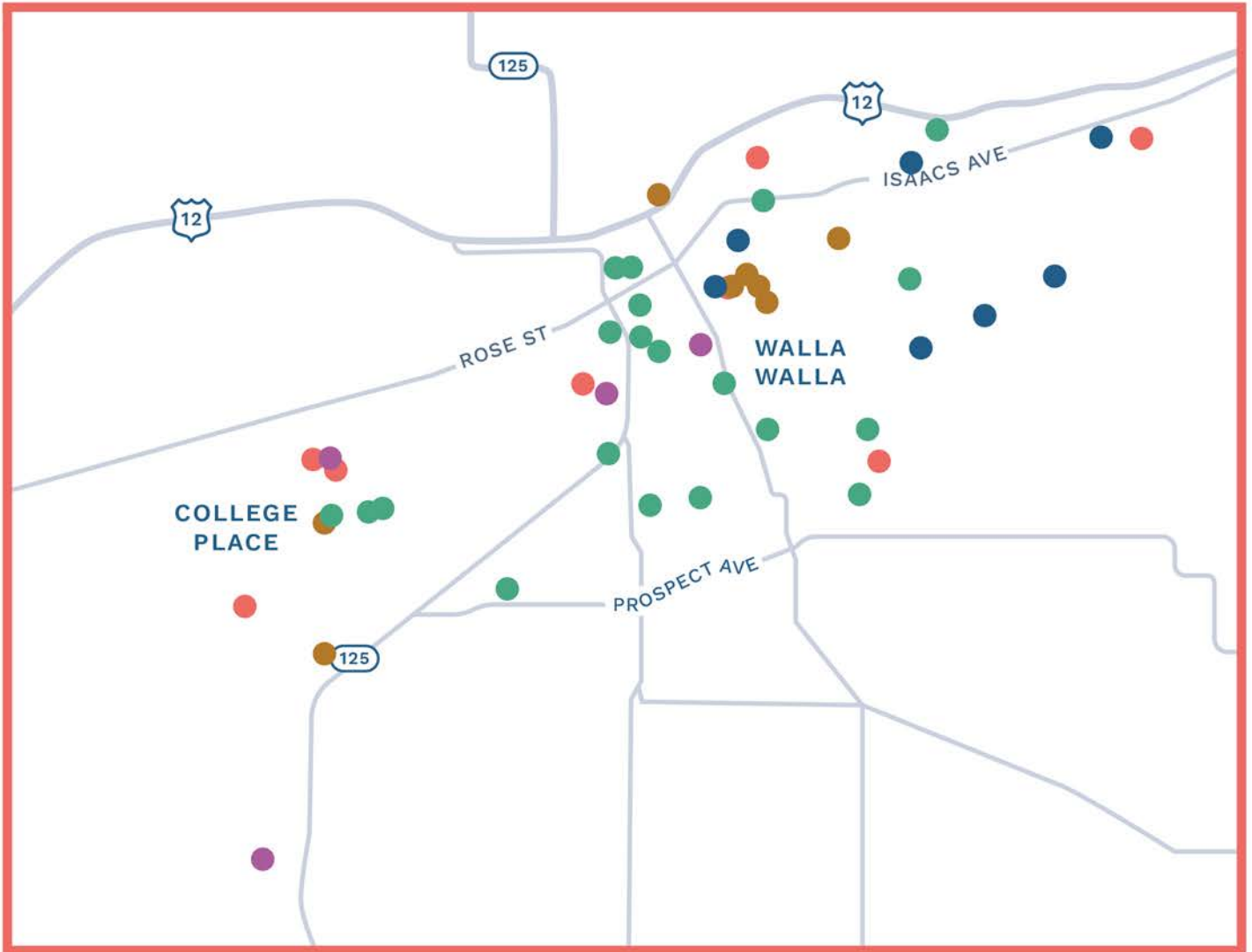

SUBSIDIES ACCEPTED OR OFFERED

A **Washington State Working Connections Child Care (WCCC)** is a state subsidy program that pays a portion of tuition costs for child care directly to the provider with program eligibility based on household income. Rates are based on type of care (family home versus center) and age of child (infant, toddler, etc.). Families making less than 65% of state median income are eligible for the subsidy with the portion of costs that parents pay capped at \$115 per month.

B **Washington State Seasonal Child Care** program is a state subsidy program that pays a portion of tuition costs for children whose guardians are seasonally employed in agricultural work. Rates are based on type of care (family home versus center) and age of child (infant, toddler, etc.).

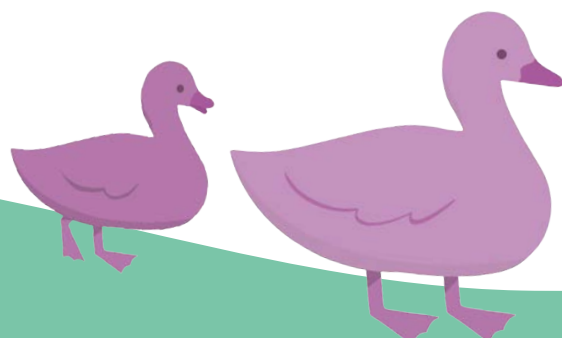

C **Military Child Care Fee Assistance** pays up to \$1,500 per child per month to providers to support tuition costs for children of military members on active duty, in the guard or reserve, army civilians, and guard and reserve technicians.

D **Providers** can offer specific subsidies or discounts not supported by state or federal funds. These are different depending on the provider, but can look like multiple child discounts, multiple year enrollment discounts, or scholarships.

SUBSIDIOS ACEPTADOS U OFRECIDOS

- A** **Washington State Working Connections Child Care (WCCC)** es un programa estatal de subsidios que paga una parte del costo de la matrícula para el cuidado infantil directamente al proveedor con elegibilidad del programa basada en los ingresos del hogar. Las tarifas se determinan según el tipo de cuidado (hogar familiar o centro) y la edad del niño (bebé, niño pequeño, etc.). Las familias que perciben menos del 65% del ingreso medio estatal pueden beneficiarse del subsidio, con la parte de los costos que corresponde pagar a los padres limitada a \$115 por mes.

- B** **El programa de Cuidado Infantil Temporal del Estado de Washington** es un programa de subsidios estatales que cubre una parte de los gastos de matrícula de los niños cuyos cuidadores desempeñan trabajos agrícolas temporales. Las tarifas se determinan según el tipo de cuidado (hogar familiar o centro) y la edad del niño (bebé, niño pequeño, etc.).

- C** **El Apoyo para Militares para el Pago de Guarderías** paga hasta \$1500 por niño al mes a los proveedores para contribuir al pago de los gastos de matrícula de los hijos de militares en servicio activo, en la guardia o en la reserva, de civiles pertenecientes al ejército y de técnicos de la guardia y de la reserva.

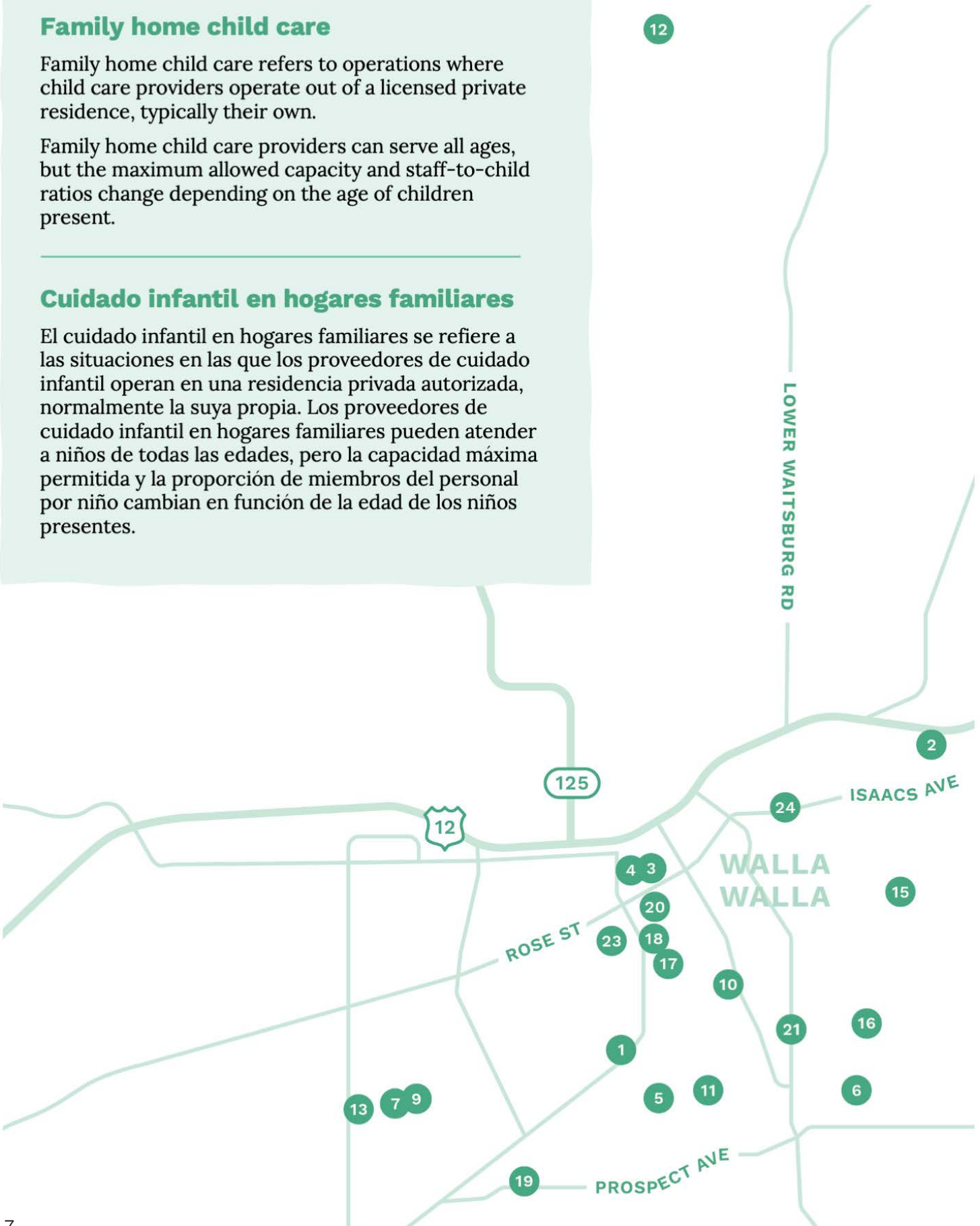
Family home child care

Family home child care refers to operations where child care providers operate out of a licensed private residence, typically their own.

Family home child care providers can serve all ages, but the maximum allowed capacity and staff-to-child ratios change depending on the age of children present.

Cuidado infantil en hogares familiares

El cuidado infantil en hogares familiares se refiere a las situaciones en las que los proveedores de cuidado infantil operan en una residencia privada autorizada, normalmente la suya propia. Los proveedores de cuidado infantil en hogares familiares pueden atender a niños de todas las edades, pero la capacidad máxima permitida y la proporción de miembros del personal por niño cambian en función de la edad de los niños presentes.

Child care centers

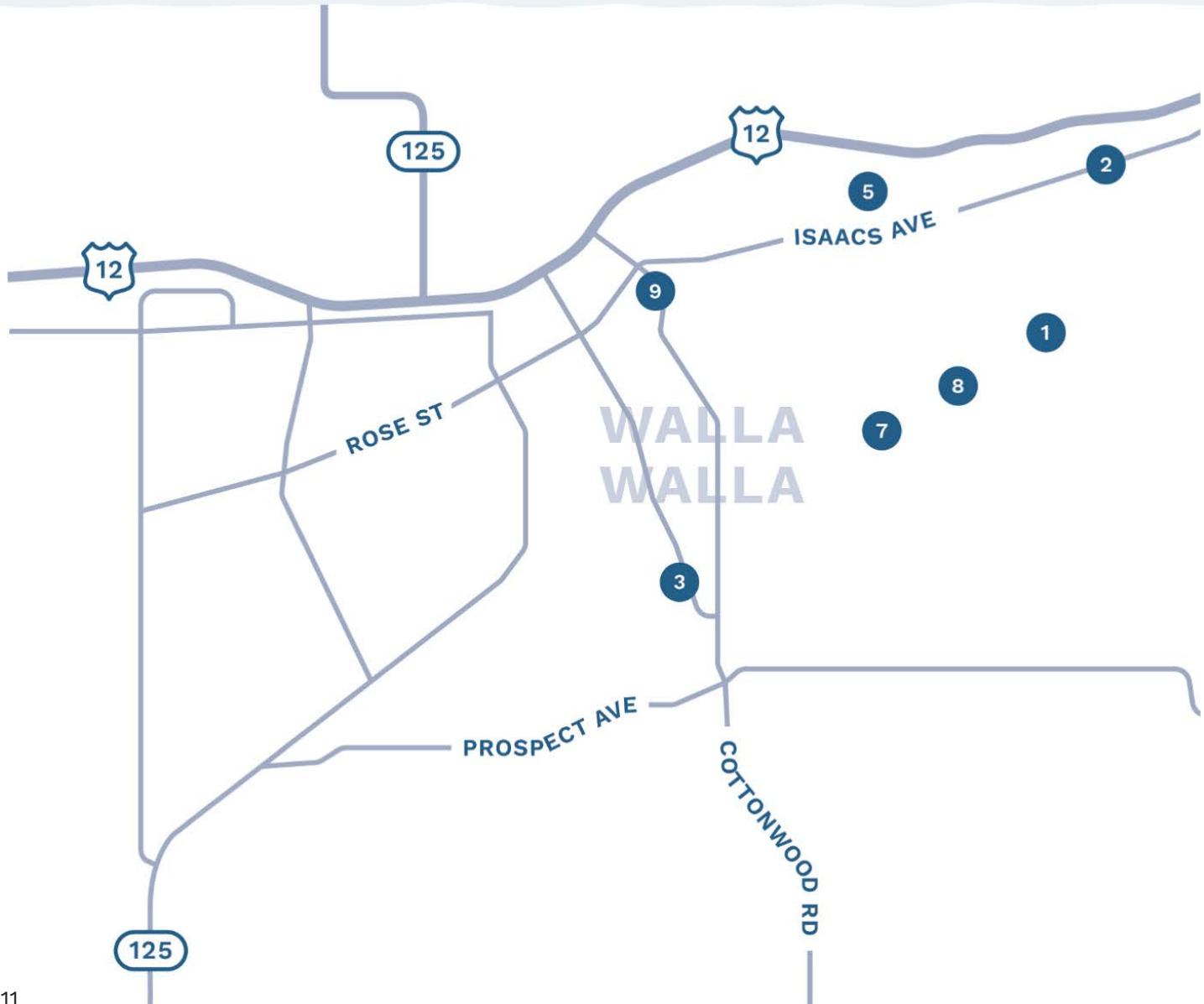
Child care centers are programs that operate in a licensed facility that is not in a private home or school.










Centers have classrooms or well-defined spaces that serve specific age groups with age-dependent maximum capacities and staff to child ratios. Like licensed family child care homes, private center providers set their own monthly or daily rates. Many providers accept or offer tuition assistance in form of subsidies, sibling discounts, or scholarships. More information is available on pg. 6 of this guide.

Centros de cuidado infantil

Los centros de cuidado infantil son programas que operan en una instalación autorizada que no es un hogar privado ni una escuela.

Los centros cuentan con aulas o espacios bien definidos que atienden a grupos de edad específicos con capacidades máximas en función de la edad y proporciones de miembros del personal por niño. Al igual que los hogares de cuidado infantil autorizados, los proveedores de centros privados establecen sus propias tarifas mensuales o diarias. Muchos proveedores aceptan u ofrecen ayudas para la matrícula en forma de subsidios, descuentos para hermanos o becas. Para más información, consulte la pág. 6 de esta guía.

Early Childhood Education Assistance Program (ECEAP), Head Start, and Early Head Start

ECEAP is an early learning program funded by Washington State for children ages 3 and 4. Program eligibility is based on family income in relation to the Washington State Median Income (SMI). In 2024, family income must be at or below 36% of SMI for a child to qualify for the program. Children who have been identified by their school district for special education, children with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP), children experiencing homelessness, and tribal children at or below 100% SMI are also eligible for ECEAP. Final eligibility for all programs will be determined by program staff.

Head Start and Early Head Start are other early learning programs funded by the federal government. Head Start programs are for children ages 3 and 4, while Early Head Start programs serve children birth to 3 years old and pregnant women. Program eligibility is based on family income in relation to the federal poverty level (FPL). In 2022, family income must be at or below 130% FPL. Children experiencing homelessness, children in foster care, and children in families with Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) cash grants are also eligible for Head Start programs. Final eligibility for all programs will be determined by program staff.

Programa de Apoyo a la Educación Infantil (ECEAP, por sus siglas en inglés), Head Start y Early Head Start

ECEAP es un programa de aprendizaje temprano financiado por el estado de Washington para niños de 3 y 4 años. La elegibilidad para el programa depende de los ingresos familiares en relación con el Ingreso Medio del Estado de Washington (SMI). En 2024, los ingresos familiares tenían que ser iguales o inferiores al 36% del SMI para que un niño pudiera acceder al programa. Los niños que han sido designados por su distrito escolar para recibir educación especial, los niños con un Plan Educativo Personalizado (IEP), los niños sin hogar y los niños de tribus con un SMI igual o inferior al 100% también pueden beneficiarse del ECEAP. La elegibilidad definitiva para todos los programas será determinada por el personal del programa.

Head Start y Early Head Start son otros programas de aprendizaje infantil financiados por el gobierno federal. Los programas Head Start son para niños de 3 y 4 años, mientras que los programas Early Head Start atienden a niños desde el nacimiento hasta los 3 años y a mujeres embarazadas. La elegibilidad para el programa depende de los ingresos familiares en relación con el nivel federal de pobreza (FPL, por sus siglas en inglés). En 2022, el ingreso familiar debía ser igual o inferior al 130% del FPL. Los niños sin hogar, los niños en hogares temporales y los niños de familias que reciben apoyos económicos del programa de Ayuda Temporal para Familias Necesitadas (TANF, por sus siglas en inglés) también pueden acceder a los programas Head Start. La elegibilidad definitiva para todos los programas será determinada por el personal del programa.

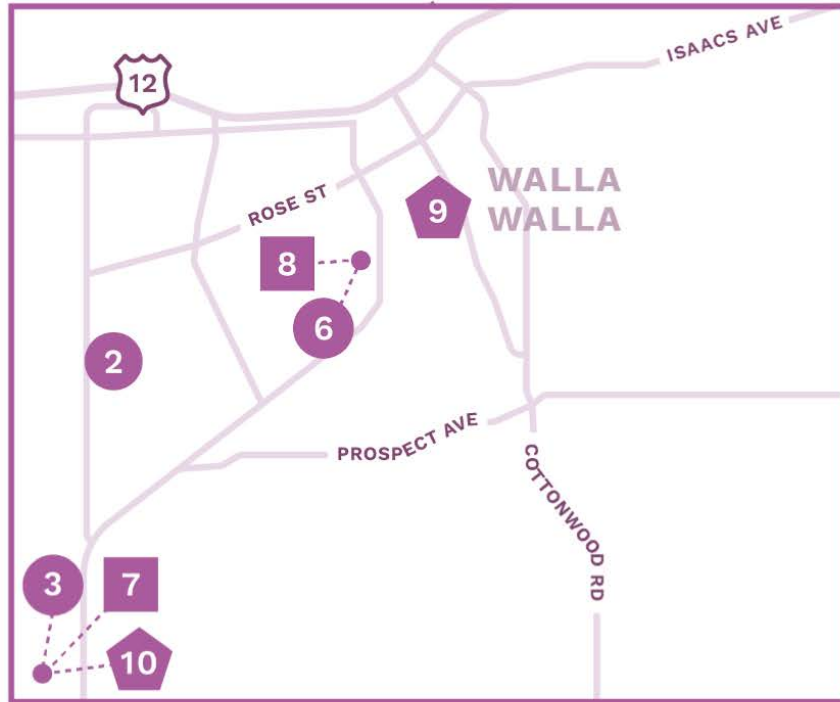

Transition to kindergarten

Transition to Kindergarten (formally called “Transitional Kindergarten”) is a school-based program for children under five years old who did not have previous access to early learning and have been screened by the school district to need preparation before entering kindergarten. Oversight for Transition to Kindergarten is provided by the Washington Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction and local school districts.

Transición al kínder

La transición al kínder (formalmente llamada "kínder de transición") es un programa escolar para niños menores de cinco años que no tuvieron acceso previo al aprendizaje temprano y que han sido considerados por el distrito escolar como alumnos que necesitan preparación antes de ingresar al kínder. La supervisión de la transición al kínder compete a la Oficina del Superintendente de Educación Pública de Washington y a los distritos escolares locales.

Partial-day preschools

Partial-day preschools operate privately on a half-day or less schedule. Each partial-day preschool has their own schedule offerings and can include morning classes, afternoon classes, and classes offered on specific days of the week. These preschools are not licensed through DCYF.

Preescolares de jornada parcial

Los preescolares de jornada parcial operan de forma privada en un horario de media jornada o menos. Cada preescolar de jornada parcial tiene su propia oferta de horarios y puede ofrecer clases por la mañana, clases por la tarde y clases en días específicos de la semana. Estos centros preescolares no cuentan con licencia del DCYF.

School district preschool programs

Sometimes school districts offer preschool programs that they design and operate entirely themselves, meaning the school district chooses the curriculum and is responsible for instruction and supervision of the children. These preschool programs typically follow school-day hours and are not licensed by the Department of Children, Youth and Families.

Programas preescolares del distrito escolar

A veces, los distritos escolares ofrecen programas preescolares que ellos mismos diseñan y administran por completo, lo que significa que el distrito escolar elige el plan de estudios y es responsable de la educación y supervisión de los niños. Estos programas preescolares suelen apegarse al horario escolar y no cuentan con licencia del Departamento de Niños, Jóvenes y Familias.

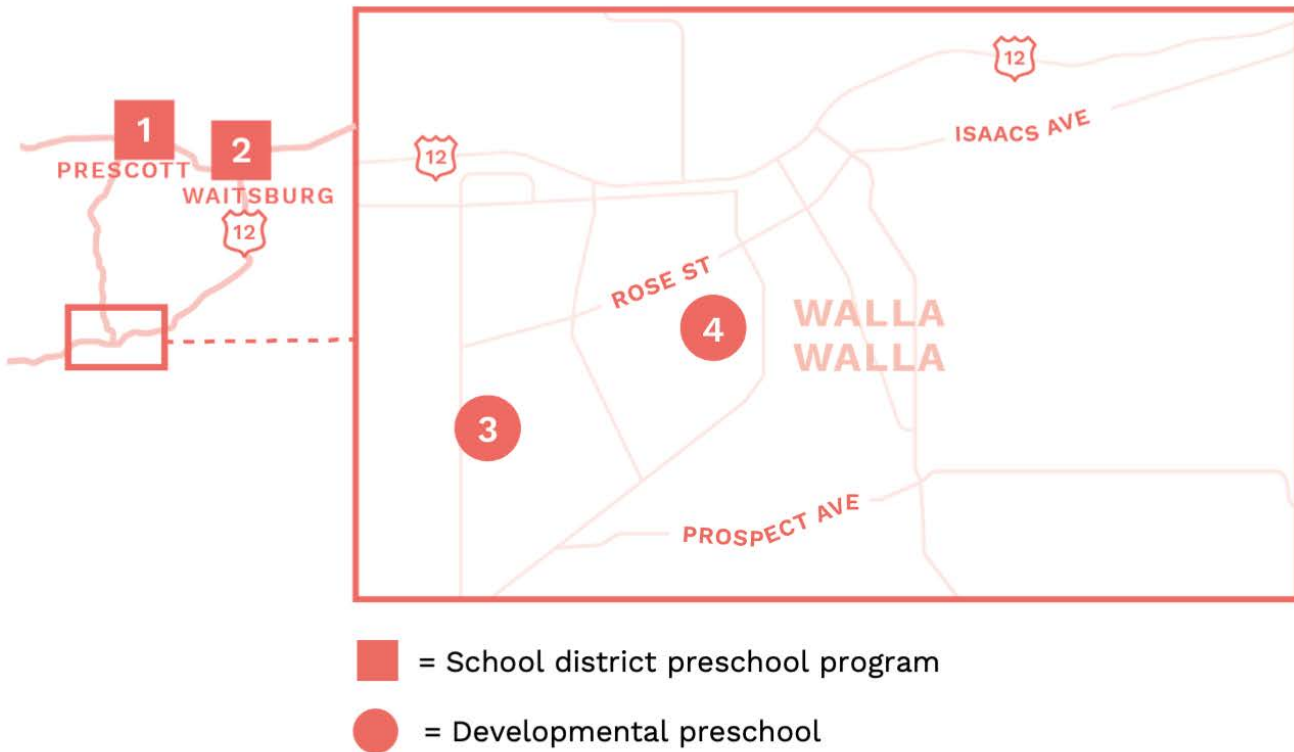
Developmental preschool

Developmental preschools serve children ages 3-5 with special needs or disabilities. Developmental preschools are usually operated by school districts and have separate morning and afternoon programs. These classes are typically smaller than others and have teachers and staff who specialize in special education. Often there is a specific process for enrolling in developmental preschool, so it is worthwhile to call the program and figure out what steps you will need to complete before the child can attend. Like most public preschool programs, developmental preschools are not licensed by the Department of Children Youth and Families.

Preescolar de desarrollo

Los preescolares de desarrollo atienden a niños de 3 a 5 años con necesidades especiales y/o discapacidades. Los preescolares de desarrollo suelen ser administrados por los distritos escolares y tienen programas distintos por la mañana y por la tarde. Estos grupos suelen ser más reducidos que los demás y cuentan con profesores y especialistas en educación especial. Suele haber un proceso específico para inscribir al niño en el preescolar de desarrollo, por lo que conviene llamar al programa para informarse de los pasos que hay que seguir antes de que el niño pueda asistir. Al igual que la mayoría de los programas preescolares públicos, los centros preescolares de desarrollo tampoco cuentan con licencia del Departamento de Niños, Jóvenes y Familias.





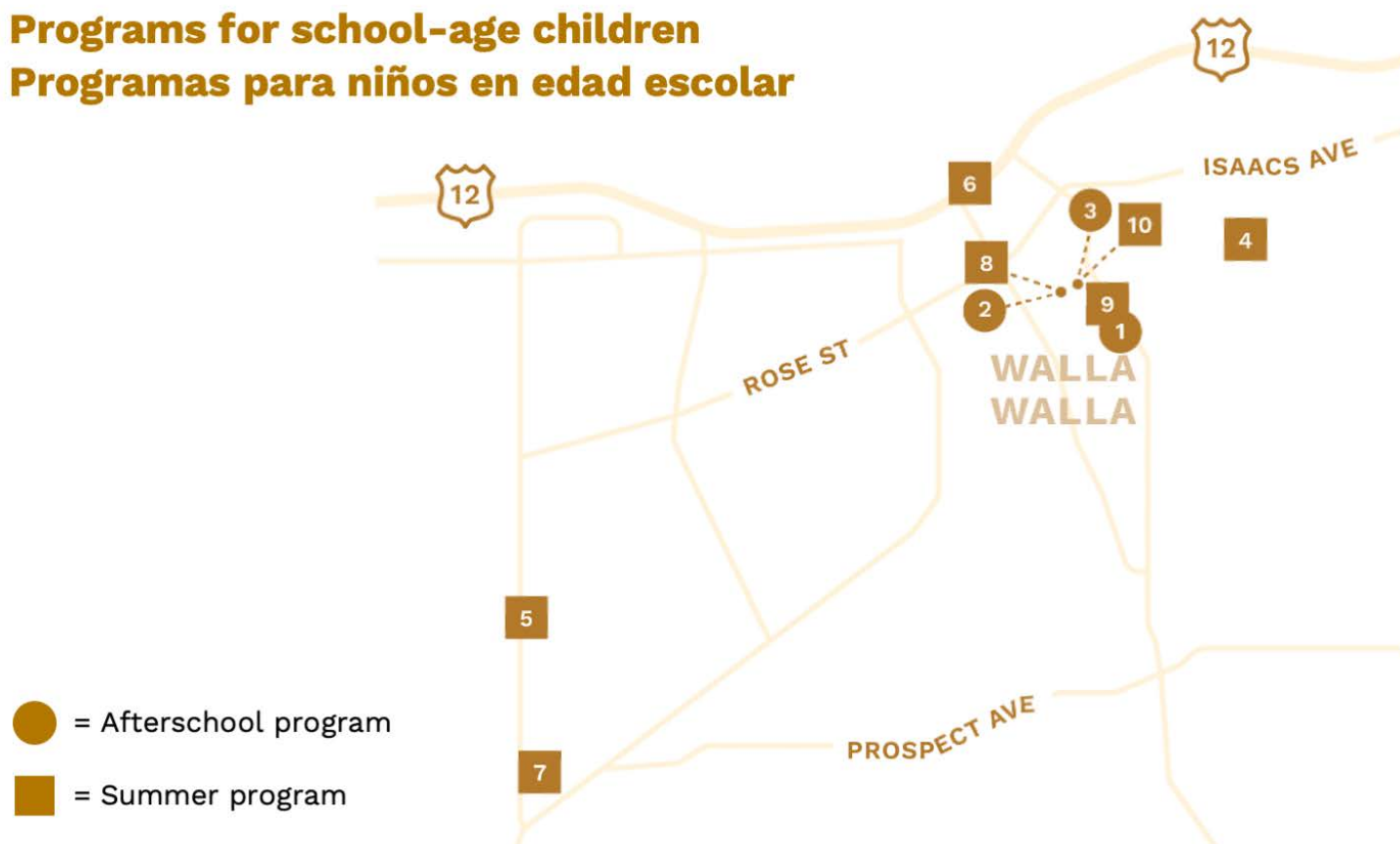
